4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 11.030, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
6	amended by amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsection
7	(c-1) to read as follows:
8	(a) The name <u>,</u> [ <del>and</del> ] address <u>, e-mail address,</u> [ <del>and a</del> ]
9	telephone <u>number</u> , social security <u>number</u> , driver's license <u>number</u> ,
10	bank account <u>number</u> , credit card <u>number</u> , or charge card number of a
11	person who purchases customer products, licenses, or services from
12	the department may not be disclosed except as authorized under this
13	section or Section 12.0251.
14	(c) The commission by rule shall adopt policies relating to:
15	(1) the release of the customer information; and
16	(2) the use of the customer information by the
17	department[ <del>; and</del>
18	(3) the sale of a mailing list consisting of the names
19	and addresses of persons who purchase customer products, licenses,
20	or services].

Subsection (c) must prohibit the sale of a mailing list that

contains any customer information described by Subsection (a) that

relates to a person who does not hold a commercial license issued by

(c-1) The policies adopted by the commission under

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- the department. Notwithstanding Subsection (d), the policies
  adopted by the commission may not be construed to restrict access to
  customer information described by Subsection (a) by a person who is
  entitled to receive the information under this section or other
  applicable law. In this subsection and Subsection (d), "mailing
  list" means one or more items of customer information described by
  Subsection (a) relating to more than one person.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
  a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
  provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
  Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
  Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
