## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain powers of groundwater conservation districts.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 36.103(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (b) A district may:
- 7 (1) acquire land to erect dams or to drain lakes,
- 8 draws, and depressions;
- 9 (2) construct dams;
- 10 (3) drain lakes, depressions, draws, and creeks;
- 11 (4) install pumps and other equipment necessary to
- 12 recharge a groundwater reservoir or its subdivision; and
- 13 (5) provide necessary facilities for <u>water</u>
- 14 conservation purposes [the purchase, sale, transportation, and
- 15 <u>distribution of water</u>].
- SECTION 2. Section 36.104, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 17 follows:
- 18 Sec. 36.104. PURCHASE, SALE, TRANSPORTATION, AND
- 19 DISTRIBUTION OF WATER. A district may purchase, sell, transport,
- and distribute surface water or groundwater [for any purpose].
- SECTION 3. Sections 36.105(a) and (b), Water Code, are
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- 23 (a) A district may exercise the power of eminent domain to
- 24 acquire by condemnation a fee simple or other interest in property

- 2 (1) within the boundaries of the district; and
- 3 (2) necessary for conservation purposes, including
- 4 <u>recharge and reuse</u> [to the exercise of the authority conferred by
- 5 this chapter].
- 6 (b) The power of eminent domain authorized in this section
- 7 may not be used for the condemnation of land for the purpose of
- 8 production, sale, or distribution of [acquiring rights to]
- 9 groundwater  $\underline{or}$  [ $\tau$ ] surface water [ $\underline{or}$  water rights].
- SECTION 4. Section 36.106, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 Sec. 36.106. SURVEYS. A district may make surveys of the
- 13 groundwater reservoir or subdivision and surveys of the facilities
- 14 [for development, production, transportation, distribution, and
- 15 use of the water, in order to determine the quantity of water
- available for production and use and to determine the improvements,
- 17 development, and recharging needed by a reservoir or its
- 18 subdivision.
- 19 SECTION 5. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 20 (b) The change in law made by this Act to Sections
- 36.103(b), 36.104, 36.105, and 36.106, Water Code, does not affect
- 22 a contract entered into before the effective date of this Act. Such
- 23 a contract is governed by the law in effect when the contract was
- 24 entered into, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 25 purpose.

- 27 Water Code, does not affect an eminent domain action initiated
