2 relating to the investigation of a firefighter or police officer in 3 certain municipalities. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 143.123(e), Local Government Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 A person may not be assigned to conduct an investigation 7 (e) if the person is the complainant, the ultimate decisionmaker 8 regarding disciplinary action, or a person who has any personal 9 involvement regarding the alleged misconduct. A fire fighter or 10 police officer who is the subject of an investigation has the right 11 12 to inquire and, on inquiry, to be informed of the identities of each investigator participating in an interrogation of the fire fighter 13 14 or police officer. Not later than the 30th day after the date that a complaint is received by an investigator, the investigator must 15 inform the fire fighter or police officer in writing of the nature 16 of the investigation and the name of each person who complained 17 18 about the fire fighter or police officer concerning the matters under investigation unless: 19 (1) a criminal investigation has been initiated as a 20 21 result of the complaint; or 22 (2) the disclosure of information concerning the name 23 of the complainant or the matters under investigation would hinder 24 a criminal investigation.

1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and 2 applies only to a complaint received by an investigator on or after 3 that date.
