A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the establishment of quantifiable goals for drought 3 contingency plans. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.1272, Water Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsections (c), (d), and (e) to read as follows: (c) By January 1, 2005, a drought contingency plan required 7 by commission rule adopted under this section must include 8 specific, quantified 3-year, 5-year, and 10-year targets for water 9 use reductions to be achieved during periods of water shortages and 10 11 drought. The entity preparing the plan shall establish the targets. 12 (d) The commission and the board by joint rule shall 13 identify quantified target goals for drought contingency plans that 14 wholesale and retail public water suppliers, irrigation districts, and other entities may use as guidelines in preparing drought 15 contingency plans. Goals established under this subsection are not 16 enforceable requirements. 17 18 (e) The commission and the board jointly shall develop model drought contingency programs for different types of water 19 suppliers that suggest best management practices for accomplishing 20 21 the highest practicable levels of water use reductions achievable during periods of water shortages and drought for each specific 22 23 type of water supplier. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24

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a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
