5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 372, Local Government
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 372.0125 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 372.0125. ADDITION OF TERRITORY. (a) A municipality
8	may add territory in the municipality or the extraterritorial
9	jurisdiction of the municipality to a public improvement district
10	created by the municipality only if requested by a petition signed
11	by:
12	(1) owners of taxable real property representing more
13	than 50 percent of the appraised value of taxable real property
14	liable for assessment in the area to be added, as determined by the
15	current roll of the appraisal district in which the property is
16	located; and
17	(2) record owners of real property liable for
18	assessment in the area to be added who:
19	(A) constitute more than 50 percent of all record
20	owners of property that is liable for assessment in the area to be
21	added; or
22	(B) own taxable real property that constitutes
23	more than 50 percent of the area of all taxable real property that
24	is liable for assessment in the area to be added.

(b) A county may add territory in the county to a public 1 2 improvement district created by the county only if requested by a 3 petition signed by: 4 (1) owners of taxable real property representing more than 50 percent of the appraised value of taxable real property 5 6 liable for assessment in the area to be added, as determined by the current roll of the appraisal district in which the property is 7 8 located; and 9 (2) record owners of real property liable for assessment in the area to be added who: 10 (A) constitute more than 50 percent of all record 11 owners of property that is liable for assessment in the area to be 12 added; or 13 14 (B) own taxable real property that constitutes 15 more than 50 percent of the area of all taxable real property that 16 is liable for assessment in the area to be added. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 19 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003. 21
