- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 42.018(g), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (g) A landowner or the landowner's agent operating under a
- 9 wildlife management plan approved by the department is, if
- 10 authorized by the commission, exempt from the tag requirements of
- 11 this section. <u>Under a wildlife management plan approved by the</u>
- department, the department may issue to the landowner a managed
- lands deer permit, may provide for different management activities
- 14 under different permitted levels, and may establish different fees
- 15 <u>for the different levels of permits.</u> The greater freedom given the
- 16 landowner in managing deer populations under the applicable permit
- 17 level, the greater the amount of the fee the department shall
- 18 <u>establish for the permit.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 43.603(c), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (c) The department may establish various levels of permits
- 22 to be issued under this subchapter, determine the activities
- 23 permitted under the respective levels, and establish different fees
- 24 for the various levels. [The department shall set a fee for the

- 1 issuance or renewal of a permit in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 43.606, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 43.606. APPLICATION OF GENERAL LAWS. Except as
- 5 expressly provided by this subchapter and the terms and conditions
- of the permit and management plan, the general laws and regulations
- 7 of this state applicable to white-tailed deer <u>do not</u> apply to deer
- 8 on the acreage covered by the permit. This subchapter does not
- 9 restrict or prohibit the use of high fences on acreage not covered
- 10 by a management plan.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
