A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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1	AN ACT
2	relating to providing financial assistance to defense communities;
3	granting of authority to issue bonds.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 4, Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Chapter 489 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 489. DEFENSE COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE LOANS
8	Sec. 489.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
9	(1) "Defense base" means a federally owned or operated
10	military installation or facility that is presently functioning or
11	that has been closed or realigned under the federal defense base
12	closure and realignment process.
13	(2) "Defense community" means a political
14	subdivision, including a municipality, county, or special
15	district, that is adjacent to, is near, or encompasses any part of a
16	defense base.
17	(3) "Office" means the Office of Defense Affairs.
18	Sec. 489.002. LOAN PROGRAM. (a) The office shall
19	administer a revolving loan program to assist defense communities
20	in developing economic development projects to maintain military
21	bases located in the community and to minimize the possibility of or

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the negative effects of defense base reduction on the community.

The office may provide a loan of financial assistance to a defense

community for economic development projects that:

1	(1) relate to defense bases in the state;
2	(2) enhance the military value of active defense bases
3	in the state; or
4	(3) mitigate the economic impact of a defense base in
5	this state being closed or realigned.
6	(b) The office by rule shall establish criteria and
7	procedures for evaluating applications for loans under the program.
8	(c) The office by rule shall establish categories of
9	economic development projects for which a defense community may
10	apply for a loan.
11	Sec. 489.003. REVOLVING LOAN ACCOUNT. (a) The defense
12	community assistance revolving loan account is an account in the
13	general revenue fund.
14	(b) The account may be used only for loans made under this
15	chapter.
16	Sec. 489.004. GIFTS AND GRANTS. The office may accept gifts
17	or grants from any source for the purposes of this chapter. The
18	office shall deposit gifts or grants to the credit of the defense
19	community assistance revolving loan account.
20	Sec. 489.005. ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR
21	DEFENSE COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE REVOLVING LOAN ACCOUNT. (a) The
22	Texas Public Finance Authority shall issue and sell general
23	obligation bonds of the state as authorized by the Texas
24	Constitution for the purpose of providing money to establish the

- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect only if the constitutional
- 4 amendment proposed by the 78th Texas Legislature, Regular Session,
- 5 2003, authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds for
- 6 economic development projects that benefit defense communities is
- 7 approved by the voters. If that amendment is not approved by the
- 8 voters, this Act has no effect.
