IN RE: HB3242 by Pitts (Relating to the use of the reverse auction procedure by state agencies.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would increase usage of the reverse auction procedure for purchases by the Building and Procurement Commission to 10% of the dollar value of goods they purchase during the 2004-05 biennium, 20% of the dollar value of goods they purchase during the 2006-07 biennium and 30% of the dollar value of goods they purchase beginning on September 1, 2007.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
