**IN RE: SB1639** by Staples (Relating to regulation of spacing and production of groundwater from aquifers by a groundwater conservation district.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would authorize in certain situations a groundwater conservation district to adopt different rules for different aquifers. The bill would take effect immediately if it receives a two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2003.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
