## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 33.088 to read as follows:
- Sec. 33.088. CERTAIN SEXUALLY SUGGESTIVE PERFORMANCES 7 PROHIBITED. (a) A school dance team, drill team, cheerleading 8 9 team, or any other performance group may not perform in a manner that is overtly sexually suggestive at an athletic or other 10 11 extracurricular event or competition sponsored or approved by a
- 12 school district or campus.

- (b) The commissioner may submit to a school district a 13 14 written request that the district review performances by a performance group described by Subsection (a) to determine if the 15 16 performances are overtly sexually suggestive.
- (c) If the school district determines that a performance 17 group described by Subsection (a) has performed in an overtly 18 sexually suggestive manner, the district shall take appropriate 19 action against the performance group and the group's sponsor, as 20 21 determined by the district.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 24
