1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the election of a director of a municipal utility  
1-10 district.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 54, Water Code, is amended  
1-13 by adding Section 54.0225 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 54.0225. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. (a) Notwithstanding  
1-15 any other law, the county clerk, or the county officer who performs  
1-16 the election duties of the county clerk, of the county in which the  
1-17 district is located shall perform the duties of the board in regard  
1-18 to an election for a member of the board.

1-19 (b) If the district is located in more than one county, the  
1-20 county clerk or other county officer of the county in which the most  
1-21 inhabitants of the district reside shall perform the election  
1-22 duties under Subsection (a).

1-23 (c) This section does not affect the duties of a board under  
1-24 Section 49.103.

1-25 (d) The district shall pay the county for election services  
1-26 required under this section in the manner provided by Subchapter D,  
1-27 Chapter 31, Election Code, for a contract to furnish election  
1-28 services.

1-29 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an  
1-30 election for a director of a municipal utility district ordered on  
1-31 or after the effective date of this Act.

1-32 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
