5	SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 37.203, Education Code,

7	(a) The center is <u>advised</u> [governed] by a board of directors

- 4 (F) a teacher from a public primary or secondary

- 9 officer whose primary duty consists of working in a public school;

- 11 (I) two members of the public.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subsection (b), Section 37.215, Education Code,
- is amended to read as follows:
- 14 (b) The <u>center</u> [board] shall biannually prepare a budget
- 15 request [for the center] for submission to the legislature.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
