## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the prosecution of the offense of criminal trespass.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 30.05(a), Penal Code, is amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (a) A person commits an offense if the person [he] enters or
  7 remains on or in property, including a recreational vehicle park or
  8 an aircraft or other vehicle, of another without effective consent
  9 or the person [he] enters or remains in a building of another
  10 without effective consent and the person [he]:
- 11 (1) had notice that the entry was forbidden; or
- 12 (2) received notice to depart but failed to do so.
- SECTION 2. Section 30.05(b), Penal Code, is amended by adding Subdivision (8) to read as follows:
- 15 (8) "Recreational vehicle park" means a tract of land
  16 that has rental spaces for two or more recreational vehicles, as
  17 defined by Section 522.004, Transportation Code.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs before the effective date. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for

- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
