- 5 SECTION 1. Article 45.0425(b), Code of Criminal Procedure,

- 7 (b) An appeal bond shall:
- 8 (1) provide [recite] that in the cause the defendant
- 9 was convicted and has appealed;
- 10 (2) [and] be conditioned that the defendant shall make
- 11 the defendant's personal appearance before the court to which the
- 12 appeal is taken instanter, if the court is in session, or, if the
- 13 court is not in session, at its next regular term, stating the time
- 14 and place of that session, and there remain from day to day and term
- to term, and answer in the cause in the court; and
- 16 (3) state the defendant's name, date of birth, and
- driver's license or personal identification certificate number, if
- 18 <u>available</u>.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to an appeal bond that is approved on or after the effective date of
- 21 this Act. An appeal bond that is approved before the effective date
- 22 of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the bond was
- 23 approved, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 24 purpose.
