5	SECTION 1. Chapter 34, Education Code, is amended by adding

7	Sec. 34.0041. IDLING BUS DIESEL ENGINE AT SCHOOL OR SCHOOL
8	EVENT PROHIBITED. (a) In this section, "idling" means allowing an
9	engine to run while the motor vehicle is not engaged in forward or
10	reverse motion.
11	(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the driver of a
12	school bus equipped with a diesel engine may not allow the idling of
13	the bus engine while the bus is parked at a school or school event.
14	(c) Subsection (b) does not prohibit the idling of a school
15	bus diesel engine:
16	(1) for the minimum time necessary to heat or cool the
17	bus before departure, provided that the engine is turned off when a
18	student is embarking or disembarking; or
19	(2) as necessary to accommodate the physical needs of
20	a student who receives special education services, regardless of
21	whether students are embarking or disembarking.
22	SECTION 2. Section 34.0041, Education Code, as added by
23	this Act, applies beginning with the 2007-2008 school year.
24	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
