H.B. No. 4065

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the establishment by the Texas Workforce Commission of a pilot program to provide grants for the construction of certain 3 facilities for job training and employment services. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code, is amended by adding Section 302.015 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 302.015. CONSTRUCTION OF JOB TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT 8 SERVICES FACILITIES; PILOT GRANT PROGRAM. (a) In this section, 9 "qualified workforce community training center" means an 10 11 organization that: 12 (1) specializes in the retail sale of donated items; 13 (2) provides job training and employment services to 14 individuals with disabilities or other barriers to employment; (3) uses a majority of its revenues for job training 15 16 and employment programs that create and foster economic 17 development; 18 (4) maintains at least a 50 percent ratio of employees who have a disability or other barrier to employment; 19 (5) operates in at least three counties, has multiple 20 21 locations, and is affiliated with a statewide organization; and (6) is exempt from federal taxation under Section 22 23 501(a), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as an organization described 24 by Section 501(c)(3) of that code.

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| 1 | (b) The commission shall establish a pilot program under |
| 2 | which the commission contracts with the Texas Association of |
| 3 | Goodwills for the commission to administer grants to reimburse |
| 4 | qualified workforce training centers identified by the Texas |
| 5 | Association of Goodwills for costs associated with the construction |
| 6 | of new facilities that provide job training or employment services. |
| 7 | The contract entered into under this subsection must provide that: |
| 8 | (1) the commission receives an administrative |
| 9 | overhead fee of one percent of the amount of each grant awarded |
| 10 | under the program; and |
| 11 | (2) each grant awarded under the program is funded |
| 12 | only on: |
| 13 | (A) the completion of the facility for which the |
| 14 | grant is awarded; and |
| 15 | (B) notification from the commission that the |
| 16 | contract terms relating to the award of the grant have been |
| 17 | satisfied. |
| 18 | (c) The total amount of grants awarded under this section |
| 19 | may not exceed \$3 million. |
| 20 | (d) The commission may adopt rules for the administration of |
| 21 | this section. |
| 22 | (e) Not later than January 1, 2009, the commission shall |
| 23 | report to the legislature regarding the commission's: |
| 24 | (1) assessment of the effectiveness of the pilot |
| 25 | program in creating and fostering economic development; and |
| 26 | (2) recommendation regarding the continuation of the |
| 27 | program. |

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1 (f) This section expires September 1, 2009. 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
