3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 4, Chapter 997, Acts of the 78th
5	Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, is amended to read as follows:
6	Sec. 4. BOUNDARIES. The Buffalo Bayou Management District
7	[district] includes all the territory contained in the following
8	described area:
9	POINT OF BEGINNING at the intersection of the center line of
10	Allen Parkway and the west boundary line of the Houston Downtown
11	Management District, then west along the center line of Allen
12	Parkway to the west boundary line of Montrose right-of-way, then
13	south along the west boundary line of Montrose right-of-way to the
14	south boundary line of West Dallas right-of-way, then west along
15	the south boundary line of West Dallas right-of-way to the
16	intersection of the west boundary line of Shepherd Drive
17	right-of-way. Then north along the west boundary line of Shepherd
18	Drive right-of-way to the intersection of the south boundary line
19	of the Memorial Drive right-of-way. Then west along the south
20	boundary line of Memorial Drive right-of-way to the intersection of
21	the west boundary line of Detering right-of-way. Then north along
22	the west boundary line of Detering right-of-way to the intersection
23	of the north boundary line of Memorial Drive right-of-way. Then
24	east along the north boundary line of Memorial Drive right-of-way

to the west boundary line of Shepherd Drive right-of-way. Then 1 2 north along the west boundary line of Shepherd Drive right-of-way 3 to the intersection of the north boundary line of Feagan Street 4 right-of-way. Then east along the north boundary line of Feagan 5 Street right-of-way until the intersection of the the west boundary 6 line of Jackson Hill Street right-of-way. Then north along the west boundary line of Jackson Hill Street right-of-way to the 7 intersection of the north boundary line of Blossom Street 8 right-of-way. Then east along the north boundary line of Blossom 9 Street right-of-way until the intersection of the east boundary 10 line of Heights Boulevard right-of-way. Then north along the east 11 12 boundary line of Heights Boulevard right-of-way to the intersection of the south boundary line of Washington Avenue right-of-way. Then 13 east along the south boundary line of Washington Avenue 14 15 right-of-way to the intersection of the west boundary line of the Washington Cemetery. Then south along the west boundary line of the 16 17 Washington Cemetery to the intersection of the north boundary line of Memorial Drive right-of-way. Then east along the north boundary 18 line of Memorial Drive right-of-way to the intersection of the 19 northeast corner of Memorial Drive right-of-way and the northern 20 21 bank of Buffalo Bayou. Then curve around the northern bank of 22 Buffalo Bayou to the northeastern corner of the intersection of the north boundary line of Memorial Drive. Then east long the north 23 24 boundary line of Memorial Drive right-of-way to the west boundary line of Silver and north along the west boundary line of Silver 25 right-of-way to the north boundary line of Memorial Drive Way 26 right-of-way. Then east along the north boundary line of Memorial 27

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Drive Way right-of-way to the west boundary line of Sabine Street 1 2 right-of-way. Then south along the west boundary line of Sabine Street right-of-way to the north boundary line of Memorial Drive 3 4 right-of-way. Then east along the north boundary line of Memorial Drive right-of-way to the west boundary line of the Houston 5 6 Downtown Management District. Then south along the west boundary 7 line of the Houston Downtown Management District to the center line of Allen Parkway, the POINT OF BEGINNING [POINT OF BEGINNING at the 8 intersection of the west boundary line of the Houston Downtown 9 Management District and the north boundary of Memorial Drive 10 right-of-way, then west along the north boundary of Memorial Drive 11 right-of-way to the north boundary of Memorial Drive's Heights 12 North exit ramp, then northwest along the north boundary of 13 Memorial Drive's Heights North exit ramp to the east boundary of 14 15 Heights boulevard right-of-way, then west across Heights Boulevard from the east boundary of Heights Boulevard right-of-way to the 16 west boundary of the Heights Boulevard right-of-way, then south 17 along the west boundary of Heights boulevard right-of-way to the 18 north boundary of Memorial Drive's Memorial West entrance ramp, 19 then southwest along the north boundary of Memorial Drive's 20 Memorial West entrance ramp to the northern boundary line of 21 22 Memorial Drive right-of-way, then west along the northern boundary line of Memorial Drive right-of-way to the west boundary line of 23 Shepherd Drive right-of-way, then south along the west boundary 24 line of Shepherd Drive right-of-way to the centerline of West 25 Dallas, then east along the centerline of West Dallas to 26 of the west boundary of Montrose Boulevard 27 intersection

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right-of-way and the centerline of West Dallas, then south along 1 the west boundary line of Montrose Boulevard right-of-way to the 2 south boundary line of U.S. Highway 59 and the west boundary line of 3 4 Montrose Boulevard right-of-way, then in an easterly direction from said intersection along the south boundary line of U.S. Highway 59 5 to the intersection of the west boundary line of the Main Street 6 right-of-way and then proceeding from said intersection in a 7 8 northwesterly direction along the boundary line of the west Main 9 Street right-of-way paralleling the boundary line of the Greater Southeast Management District to the intersection of the boundary 10 line of the south Portland Street right-of-way and the boundary 11 line of the west Main Street right-of-way, being the southern 12 boundary line of the Midtown Management District, then proceeding 13 from said intersection in generally a northeasterly direction the 14 15 boundary line parallels the Midtown Management District boundary line to the intersection of the west boundary line of the US Hwy 45 16 right-of-way and the north boundary line of the Cleveland Street 17 right-of-way, being the western boundary line of the Houston 18 Downtown Management District, then north from said intersection 19 along the western boundary line of the Houston Downtown Management 20 District to the POINT OF BEGINNING]. 21

22 SECTION 2. Sections 3820.051(a) and (b), Special District 23 Local Laws Code, are amended to read as follows:

(a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the district is
governed by a board of <u>nine</u> [<del>31</del>] voting directors appointed under
Section 3820.052 and nonvoting directors as provided by Section
3820.053.

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H.B. No. 4113 (b) Voting directors serve staggered terms of four years, 1 2 with <u>four</u> [15] or <u>five</u> [16] directors' terms expiring June 1 of each 3 odd-numbered year. SECTION 3. 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SECTION 5. The legislature finds that:

3 (1) proper and legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 4 5 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 6 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished by 7 8 the constitution and laws of this state, including the governor, 9 who has submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on 10 Environmental Quality;

(2) the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives within the required time;

(3) the general law relating to consent by political subdivisions to the creation of districts with conservation, reclamation, and road powers and the inclusion of land in those districts has been complied with; and

(4) all requirements of the constitution and laws of
this state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with
respect to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act have
been fulfilled and accomplished.

23 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
