R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Inasmuch as the great, sovereign State of Texas has  
2 been unquestionably blessed by its Creator; and

3           WHEREAS, Proof of such blessings lies in the unquestionable  
4 fact that, when created, Texas received, along with all the other  
5 blessings given to the Earth, taller, billowing prairie grasses;  
6 gentler, winding, clear rivers; bluer skies; redder sunsets; faster  
7 horses; more unique animals; the most beautiful wildflowers, each  
8 honored with its very own season and the *most* beautiful of which is  
9 the bluebonnet, which is found only within the boundaries of Texas;  
10 fatter deer; oranger longhorns; more beautiful women; smarter  
11 children; and kinder men; and

12           WHEREAS, Instilled within those blessed to reside within the  
13 borders of the state is a fierce pride, which provides assurance  
14 that this portion of Earth will flourish and not perish and that its  
15 inhabitants will band together and fight, if need be, to the death  
16 to preserve the blessing of the land and its contents; and

17           WHEREAS, When this Earth was set forth, it was set perfectly  
18 and with its own distinct boundaries; those boundaries include the  
19 Northern Pole of the Earth and the opposite, Southern Pole of the  
20 Earth; and

21           WHEREAS, It therefore stands to reason that a West Pole of the  
22 Earth would be understood to exist, and that it would be designed to  
23 be placed in the blessed and beloved Texas territory; and

24           WHEREAS, The location of the West Pole has been searched for,

1 researched, and found to be located at 30 degrees, 18.25' north  
2 latitude and 97 degrees, 56.28' west longitude, in Bee Cave, Texas;  
3 now, therefore, be it

4           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas  
5 Legislature recognize the presumed site of the West Pole as being in  
6 the sovereign State of Texas and acknowledge and accept it as
