- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 524.036, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 524.036. FAILURE TO APPEAR; APPEARANCE OF
- 9 WITNESSES. (a) A person who requests a hearing and fails to appear
- 10 without just cause waives the right to a hearing and the
- 11 department's determination is final.
- 12 (b) A person, including a peace officer or an expert
- witness, may not be compelled to appear at a hearing under this
- 14 subchapter.
- 15 (c) A person other than a person who requests a hearing
- 16 under this subchapter, including a peace officer or expert witness,
- in lieu of appearing at the hearing, may submit an affidavit that
- 18 sets out the matters the person would testify to at the hearing.
- (d) The department by rule shall adopt a form for use as an
- 20 <u>affidavit under Subsection (c).</u>
- SECTION 2. Sections 524.038(d) and 524.039, Transportation
- 22 Code, are repealed.
- SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 24 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this

- 1 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- 2 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 3 before that date.
- 4 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 5 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 6 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
