- 3 (1) Strike page 2, line 2, through page 12, line 8 of the

- 5 (2) Add the following appropriately numbered items to the
- 6 amendment and renumber subsequent items of the amendment
- 7 accordingly:
- 8 (\_) Strike SECTIONS 1.01 and 1.02 of Article 1 of the bill
- 9 (page 1, line 9, through page 2, line 24) and substitute the
- 10 following:
- 11 SECTION 1.01. Sections 201.051(a), (b), and (d),
- 12 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) The Texas Transportation Commission consists of  $\underline{15}$
- 14 [five] members, with 14 members elected from geographic
- 15 districts and one member elected at large [appointed by the
- 16 governor with the advice and consent of the senate].
- 17 (b) The legislature shall, at its first regular session
- 18 after the publication of each United States decennial census,
- 19 reapportion the geographic districts described in Subsection
- 20 (a). The districts shall be substantially equal in population,
- 21 according to the most recent United States decennial census.
- 22 The legislature shall consider county lines, senatorial and
- 23 representative districts, and commissioners precincts in the
- 24 reapportionment process [members shall be appointed to reflect
- 25 the diverse geographic regions and population groups of this
- 26 state. One member must reside in a rural area].
- 27 (d) A [Except as provided by Subsection (e), a] person may
- 28 not serve [is not eligible for appointment] as a member of the
- 29 commission if the person or the person's spouse:

- 1 (1) is employed by or participates in the management
- 2 of a business entity or other organization that is regulated by
- 3 or receives funds from the department;
- 4 (2) directly or indirectly owns or controls more than
- 5 10 percent interest in a business entity or other organization
- 6 that is regulated by or receives funds from the department;
- 7 (3) uses or receives a substantial amount of tangible
- 8 goods, services, or funds from the department, other than
- 9 compensation or reimbursement authorized by law for commission
- 10 membership, attendance, or expenses; or
- 11 (4) is registered, certified, or licensed by the
- 12 department.
- 13 SECTION 1.02. Section 201.053(a), Transportation Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) The member of the commission elected at large is
- 16 [governor periodically shall designate one commissioner as] the
- 17 chair of the commission, who shall serve as presiding officer of
- 18 the commission.
- 19 (\_) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to
- 20 Article 1 of the bill and renumber subsequent SECTIONS of that
- 21 article as appropriate:
- 22 SECTION 1.\_\_\_. Section 201.052, Transportation Code, is
- 23 amended to read as follows:
- 24 Sec. 201.052. TERMS. Members of the commission elected
- 25 <u>from geographic districts</u> serve <u>two-year</u> [<del>staggered six year</del>]
- 26 terms, and the member elected at large serves a four-year term.
- 27 <u>The</u> [, with the] terms of the [either one or two] members expire
- 28 January [expiring February] 1 of an [each] odd-numbered year.
- 29 SECTION 1.\_\_\_. Section 52.092(c), Election Code, is
- 30 amended to read as follows:
- 31 (c) Statewide offices of the state government shall be
- 32 listed in the following order:
