- Amend C.S.H.B. No. 2730 (house committee printing) by
- 2 adding the following appropriately numbered ARTICLE to the bill
- 3 and renumbering subsequent ARTICLES of the bill accordingly:
- 4 ARTICLE ____. DISPLAY OF LICENSE TO
- 5 CARRY A CONCEALED HANDGUN
- 6 SECTION ____.01. Sections 411.187(a) and (c), Government
- 7 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) A license may be suspended under this section if the
- 9 license holder:
- 10 (1) is charged with the commission of a Class A or
- 11 Class B misdemeanor or an offense under Section 42.01, Penal
- 12 Code, or of a felony under an information or indictment;
- 13 (2) [fails to display a license as required by
- 14 Section 411.205;
- 15 $\left[\frac{(3)}{(3)}\right]$ fails to notify the department of a change of
- 16 address or name as required by Section 411.181;
- 17 (3) [(4)] carries a concealed handgun under the
- 18 authority of this subchapter of a different category than the
- 19 license holder is licensed to carry;
- 20 (4) [(5)] fails to return a previously issued license
- 21 after a license is modified as required by Section 411.184(d);
- (5) [(6)] commits an act of family violence and is
- 23 the subject of an active protective order rendered under Title
- 24 4, Family Code; or
- (6) [(7)] is arrested for an offense involving family
- 26 violence or an offense under Section 42.072, Penal Code, and is
- 27 the subject of an order for emergency protection issued under
- 28 Article 17.292, Code of Criminal Procedure.
- 29 (c) A license may be suspended under this section:

- 1 (1) for 30 days, if the person's license is subject
- 2 to suspension for a reason listed in Subsection (a)(2), (3)
- $[\frac{(a)(3)}{3}]$, or (4), $[\frac{or}{5}]$ except as provided by Subdivision
- 4 (2) [-(3)];
- 5 (2) [for 90 days, if the person's license is subject
- 6 to suspension for a reason listed in Subsection (a)(2), except
- 7 as provided by Subdivision (3);
- 8 $\left[\frac{(3)}{(3)}\right]$ for not less than one year and not more than
- 9 three years if the person's license is subject to suspension for
- 10 a reason listed in Subsection (a), other than the reason listed
- 11 in Subsection (a)(1), and the person's license has been
- 12 previously suspended for the same reason;
- 13 (3) [(4)] until dismissal of the charges if the
- 14 person's license is subject to suspension for the reason listed
- 15 in Subsection (a)(1); or
- 16 (4) [(5)] for the duration of or the period specified
- 17 by:
- 18 (A) the protective order issued under Title 4,
- 19 Family Code, if the person's license is subject to suspension
- 20 for the reason listed in Subsection (a)(5) [(a)(6)]; or
- 21 (B) the order for emergency protection issued
- 22 under Article 17.292, Code of Criminal Procedure, if the
- 23 person's license is subject to suspension for the reason listed
- 24 in Subsection (a)(6) $\left[\frac{(a)(7)}{(a)}\right]$.
- 25 SECTION ___.02. Section 411.205, Government Code, is
- 26 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 411.205. REQUIREMENT TO DISPLAY [DISPLAYING]
- 28 LICENSE[; PENALTY]. [(a)] If a license holder is carrying a
- 29 handgun on or about the license holder's person when a
- 30 magistrate or a peace officer demands that the license holder
- 31 display identification, the license holder shall display both
- 32 the license holder's driver's license or identification

- 1 certificate issued by the department and the license holder's
- 2 handgun license. [A person who fails or refuses to display the
- 3 license and identification as required by this subsection is
- 4 subject to suspension of the person's license as provided by
- 5 Section 411.187.
- 6 [\(\frac{(b)}{A}\) person commits an offense if the person fails or
- 7 refuses to display the license and identification as required by
- 8 Subsection (a) after previously having had the person's license
- 9 suspended for a violation of that subsection. An offense under
- 10 this subsection is a Class B misdemeanor.]
- 11 SECTION ___.03. An offense under Section 411.205,
- 12 Government Code, may not be prosecuted after the effective date
- 13 of this article. If, on the effective date of this article, a
- 14 criminal action is pending for an offense under Section 411.205,
- 15 the action is dismissed on that date. However, a final
- 16 conviction for an offense under Section 411.205 that exists on
- 17 the effective date of this article is unaffected by this
- 18 article.
- 19 SECTION ___.04. This article takes effect September 1,
- 20 2009.
