A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the award of course credit to a student at a public

3 institution of higher education for the completion of military

4 service.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 51, Education Code, is

7 amended by adding Section 51.3042 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 51.3042. AWARD OF COURSE CREDIT FOR MILITARY SERVICE.

9 (a) In this section, "institution of higher education" has the

10 meaning assigned by Section 61.003.

- 11 (b) An institution of higher education shall award to an
- 12 undergraduate student who is admitted to the institution, including
- 13 <u>a student who is readmitted under Section 51.9242, course credit</u>
- 14 for all physical education courses required by the institution for
- 15 an undergraduate degree and for additional semester credit hours,
- 16 not to exceed 12, that may be applied to satisfy any elective course
- 17 requirements for the student's degree program for courses outside
- 18 the student's major or minor if the student:
- 19 <u>(1) graduated from a public or private high school in</u>
- 20 this state accredited by a generally recognized accrediting
- 21 organization or from a high school operated by the United States
- 22 Department of Defense; and
- 23 (2) is an honorably discharged former member of the
- 24 armed forces of the United States who:

- 1 (A) completed at least two years of service in
- 2 the armed forces; or
- 3 (B) was discharged because of a disability.
- 4 (c) This section does not prohibit an institution of higher
- 5 education from awarding additional course credit for a student's
- 6 military service as the institution considers appropriate.
- 7 (d) An institution of higher education may adopt rules
- 8 requiring reasonable proof from a student of the fact and duration
- 9 of the student's military service and of the student's military
- 10 discharge status.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 51.3042, Education Code, as added by
- 12 this Act, applies to a student attending an institution of higher
- 13 education, without regard to whether the student was admitted to
- 14 the institution before the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
