- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 10, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 10.007 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 10.007. NOTICE TO OFFICE OF COURT ADMINISTRATION;
- 8 DISSEMINATION OF LIST. (a) A clerk of a court shall provide the
- 9 Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System a copy
- 10 of any signed pleading or motion that a court has determined to
- 11 constitute conduct violating Section 10.001.
- 12 (b) The Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial
- 13 System shall maintain a list of litigants signing frivolous
- 14 pleadings or motions in violation of Section 10.001 and shall
- 15 annually send the list to the general counsel of the State Bar of
- 16 Texas, who may use the information to determine whether an attorney
- 17 <u>involved</u> in conduct violating Section 10.001 is subject to
- discipline by the state bar.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a pleading or a motion
- in an action commenced on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 21 pleading or motion in an action commenced before the effective date
- of this Act is governed by the law applicable to the pleading or
- 23 motion immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that
- law is continued in effect for that purpose.
