- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2007.003(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:

- 9 (1) the adoption or issuance of an ordinance, rule,
- 10 regulatory requirement, resolution, policy, guideline, or similar
- 11 measure;
- 12 (2) an action that imposes a physical invasion or
- 13 requires a dedication or exaction of private real property;

- 15 (A) has effect in the extraterritorial

- 17 enacts or enforces an ordinance, rule, regulation, or plan that
- 18 does not impose identical requirements or restrictions in the
- 19 entire extraterritorial jurisdiction of the municipality; or

- 21 prohibits development of a mineral interest; and

- 1 citations, orders, judicial or quasi-judicial proceedings, or
- 2 other similar means.
- 3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by Section 2007.003(a),
- 4 Government Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to an action
- 5 the effective date of which occurs on or after the effective date of
- 6 this Act. An action the effective date of which occurs before the
- 7 effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the
- 8 conduct occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 9 purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
