A license applicant 8 who is a graduate of a medical school that is located outside the 9 United States and Canada must present proof satisfactory to the 10 11 board that the applicant: 12 (1) is a graduate of a school whose curriculum meets 13 the requirements for an unapproved medical school as determined by 14 a committee of experts selected by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board; 15 has successfully completed at least three years of 16 (2) graduate medical training in the United States or Canada that was 17 approved by the board; 18 (3) [is eligible for a license to practice medicine in 19 the country in which the school is located, except for 20 any 21 citizenship requirements; 22 [(4)] holds a valid certificate issued by the 23 Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates; and 24 (4) [(5)] is able to communicate in English.

1 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 2 to physician applicants submitting license applications under 3 Chapter 155, Occupations Code, on or after the effective date of 4 this Act. An application submitted before that date is covered by 5 the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this 6 Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
