4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 22, Penal Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 22.042 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 22.042. CONTRIBUTING TO DELINQUENCY OF A CHILD. (a) A
8	person commits an offense if the person is 17 years of age or older
9	and intentionally or knowingly causes or encourages a child to:
10	(1) engage in specific conduct that, under the
11	circumstances surrounding the actor's conduct, would cause the
12	child to be present during the commission of a felony; or
13	(2) enter or remain in a place where:
14	(A) a controlled substance, a controlled
15	substance analogue, drug paraphernalia, or marihuana, as defined by
16	Chapter 481, Health and Safety Code, is used, possessed,
17	manufactured, or distributed; or
18	(B) prostitution is practiced.
19	(b) In this section:
20	(1) "Child" means any person younger than 17 years of
21	age.
22	(2) "Place" means:
23	(A) the grounds of a park, lot, or parcel of land;

- 1 (B) a building or a portion of a building,
- 2 including a distinct residential or lodging unit, but not including
- 3 <u>a residential or lodging structure that does not have a living area</u>
- 4 in common.
- 5 (c) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 6 (d) If conduct constituting an offense under this section
- 7 also constitutes an offense under another section of this code, the
- 8 actor may be prosecuted under either section or under both
- 9 sections.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
