2 was all too brief, but this brave and irrepressible young lady  
3 filled her days and countless hearts with joy, love, and laughter  
4 before her passing on January 24, 2009, at the age of 15; and

5        WHEREAS, Ms. Hussmann was born in El Paso on May 13, 1993, to  
6 Amy and Harry Hussmann; she attended Polk Elementary School and  
7 Hornedo Middle School before going on to Franklin High School,  
8 where she excelled in volleyball and basketball; in addition, the  
9 athletic youngster played with the El Paso Wildfire Volleyball Club  
10 and was a member of the regional High Performance Junior Olympic  
11 Pipeline team; her warm, outgoing personality and sense of humor  
12 brought her many friends, who joined her family in fond indulgence  
13 of the self-identified "rock star" in their midst; and

14       WHEREAS, When she received a terminal diagnosis, Ms. Hussmann  
15 revealed her true star quality; she made it her mission to have all  
16 the fun she possibly could in the time that remained to her, and she  
17 drew family and friends along in her adventures; moreover, she  
18 allowed the *El Paso Times* to chronicle her journey, touching many  
19 lives with her courage and determination to enjoy every moment; her  
20 mother helped her create a list of things she most wanted to  
21 experience, and her friends and family members joined her in  
22 activities that ranged from getting henna tattoos and baking  
23 cookies to an exciting trip to New York and a helicopter ride; and

24       WHEREAS, Her unflagging optimism was a blessing to those she

2 others; she wrote a book for younger children facing serious  
3 illness and titled it *Hope Is Here*; her mottos were "twice as

6 to be part of her celebration of life; in tribute, residents of El  
7 Paso held a parade for her and Hospice El Paso is naming its  
8 education auditorium "Margaret's Room"; and

10 her dear, and she is mourned by the thousands in El Paso and across  
11 the country who came to admire her; however, though tears may still  
12 fall, the many funny stories, sweet memories, and profound lessons
