## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the availability of a property owners' association's 3 books and records. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 209.005, Property Code, is amended by 5 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as 6 7 follows: (a) A property owners' association shall make the books and 8 9 records of the association, including financial records, reasonably available to an owner in accordance with Section B, 10 Article 2.23, Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act (Article 1396-2.23, 11 12 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), or a successor to that statute. (c) If a property owners' association subject to Subsection 13 14 (a) fails to comply with Subsection (a), an owner may seek one or more of the following remedies: 15 16 (1) a court order directing the property owners' association to provide the required information; 17 18 (2) a judgment against the property owners' association for a penalty of not more than \$1,500; 19 (3) a judgment against the property owners' 20 association for court costs and attorney's fees incurred in 21 connection with seeking a remedy under this section; or 22 23 (4) a judgment authorizing the owner or the owner's 24 assignee to deduct the amounts awarded under Subdivisions (2) and

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## (3) from any future regular or special assessments payable to the property owners' association.

SECTION 2. Subsection (c), Section 209.005, Property Code, 3 added by this Act, applies only to a property owners' 4 as association's failure to comply with Subsection (a), Section 5 6 209.005, Property Code, on or after the effective date of this Act. A property owners' association's failure to comply with that 7 subsection before the effective date of this Act is governed by the 8 law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and 9 that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 10

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2010.
