## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to eliminating the set-aside of a portion of designated
- 3 tuition for student financial assistance at public institutions of
- 4 higher education.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 56, Education Code, is
- 7 repealed.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 56.465(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (a) The governing board of each institution of higher
- 11 education shall cause to be set aside five percent of the amount of
- 12 the tuition charged to a resident undergraduate student at the
- 13 institution under Section 54.0513 in excess of \$46 per semester
- 14 credit hour. [The amount of a student's tuition set aside under
- 15 this subsection is considered a part of the amount required to be
- 16 set aside from that tuition under Section 56.011.
- 17 SECTION 3. (a) The repeal of Subchapter B, Chapter 56,
- 18 Education Code, by this Act applies beginning with tuition charged
- 19 for the 2009 fall semester.
- 20 (b) The repeal of Subchapter B, Chapter 56, Education Code,
- 21 by this Act does not affect the application of that subchapter to
- 22 tuition set aside for purposes of that subchapter for any semester
- 23 or other academic term before the 2009 fall semester, and the former
- 24 law is continued in effect until the tuition set aside before the

- 1 2009 fall semester has been used as prescribed by that subchapter.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
