**IN RE: SJR41** by Duncan (Proposing a constitutional amendment to replace the attorney general on the legislative redistricting board with the commissioner of agriculture.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated**, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$90,882.

The resolution would amend Section 28, Article III of the Texas Constitution to replace the attorney general on the legislative redistricting board with the commissioner of agriculture.
