Amend CSHB 2694 (house committee printing) as follows:

(1) Strike page 23, line 27, through page 25, line 6, and substitute the following appropriately numbered SECTION:

SECTION 4.____. Section 26.3574(b), Water Code, is amended to read as follows:

(b) A fee is imposed on the delivery of a petroleum product on withdrawal from bulk of that product as provided by this subsection. Each operator of a bulk facility on withdrawal from bulk of a petroleum product shall collect from the person who orders the withdrawal a fee in an amount determined as follows:

(1) $\frac{\$3.125}{\$3.75}$ [\$3.75] for each delivery into a cargo tank having a capacity of less than 2,500 gallons for the state fiscal year beginning September 1, 2011 [2007], through the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2015 [2011];

(2) $\frac{6.25}{7.50}$ for each delivery into a cargo tank having a capacity of 2,500 gallons or more but less than 5,000 gallons for the state fiscal year beginning September 1, $\frac{2011}{2007}$, through the state fiscal year ending August 31, $\frac{2015}{2011}$;

(3) $\frac{\$9.37}{\$11.75}$ for each delivery into a cargo tank having a capacity of 5,000 gallons or more but less than 8,000 gallons for the state fiscal year beginning September 1, $\frac{2011}{$2007$}$, through the state fiscal year ending August 31, $\frac{2015}{$2011$}$

(4) $\frac{\$12.50}{\$12.50}$ [$\frac{\$15.00}{\$15.00}$] for each delivery into a cargo tank having a capacity of 8,000 gallons or more but less than 10,000 gallons for the state fiscal year beginning September 1, $\frac{2011}{$2007}$], through the state fiscal year ending August 31, $\frac{2015}{$2011}$]; and

(5) $\frac{6.25}{2000} [\frac{7.50}{100}]$ for each increment of 5,000 gallons or any part thereof delivered into a cargo tank having a capacity of 10,000 gallons or more for the state fiscal year beginning September 1, 2011 [2007], through the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2015 [2011].

(2) On page 32, strike lines 3 through 8.
