A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to an exemption from the sales tax on handguns, rifles,
- 3 shotguns, and ammunition.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 151.344 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 151.344. HANDGUNS, RIFLES, SHOTGUNS, AND AMMUNITION.
- 8 The sale of a handgun, a rifle, a shotgun, or ammunition for a
- 9 handgun, rifle, or shotgun is exempted from the taxes imposed by
- 10 this chapter if the sale takes place during the period described by
- 11 Section 151.326(a)(2).
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 13 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this
- 14 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been
- 15 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the
- 16 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
- 17 the liability for those taxes.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
