- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the Bill Burch Act.
- 5 SECTION 2. Subtitle H, Title 2, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Chapter 172 to read as follows:

7 CHAPTER 172. MOMENT THAT LIFE BEGINS

- 8 Sec. 172.001. MOMENT THAT LIFE BEGINS. The life of an
- 9 individual human organism begins at the moment that the initial
- 10 <u>splitting of a human cell occurs during fertilization.</u>
- 11 Sec. 172.002. RIGHTS OF UNBORN. An unborn human organism is
- 12 alive and is entitled to the rights, protections, and privileges
- 13 <u>accorded to any other person in this state.</u>
- 14 Sec. 172.003. POWER TO ENACT. This chapter is enacted
- 15 pursuant to the power reserved to this state under the Tenth
- 16 Amendment to the United States Constitution.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
