9	SECTION 2. Title 8, Penal Code, is amended by adding Chapter
10	40 to read as follows:
11	CHAPTER 40. CERTAIN EMPLOYMENT OR CONTRACTS PROHIBITED UNDER
12	FEDERAL LAW
13	Sec. 40.01. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "unauthorized
14	alien" has the meaning assigned by 8 U.S.C. Section 1324a(h)(3).
15	Sec. 40.02. EMPLOYING OR CONTRACTING WITH UNAUTHORIZED
16	ALIEN. (a) A person commits an offense if the person
17	intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly:
18	(1) employs an unauthorized alien;
19	(2) contracts for the performance of labor or other
20	work with an unauthorized alien; or
21	(3) contracts or subcontracts for the performance of
22	labor or other work with another person the actor knows will employ
23	or contract with an unauthorized alien to perform labor or other
24	work under the contract or subcontract.

- 1 (b) An offense under this section is a state jail felony.
- 2 Sec. 40.03. EXCEPTIONS. It is an exception to the
- 3 application of Section 40.02 that the actor:
- 4 (1) employed or contracted with the unauthorized
- 5 <u>alien</u>, or entered into a contract or subcontract described by
- 6 Section 40.02(a)(3), for the purpose of obtaining labor or other
- 7 work to be performed exclusively or primarily at a single-family
- 8 residence in which the actor resides; or
- 9 (2) attempted to verify the unauthorized alien's
- 10 immigration status or work authorization in a manner that is more
- 11 likely than not to produce a correct and reliable result concerning
- 12 <u>an individual's immigration status or work authorization and had no</u>
- 13 knowledge of the unauthorized alien's actual immigration status or
- 14 work authorization.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
