## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to payment of the costs for services of a guardian ad litem

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 665A, Texas Probate Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 665A. PAYMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES. (a) The
- 8 court shall order the payment of a fee set by the court as
- 9 compensation to the attorneys, mental health professionals, and
- 10 interpreters appointed under this chapter, as applicable, to be
- 11 taxed as costs in the case. If after examining the proposed ward's
- 12 assets the court determines the proposed ward is unable to pay for
- 13 services provided by an attorney, a mental health professional, or
- 14 an interpreter appointed under this chapter, as applicable, the
- 15 county is responsible for the cost of those services, except as
- 16 provided by Subsection (b) of this section.
- 17 (b) If the proposed ward's assets are insufficient to pay
- 18 for the cost of an attorney ad litem appointed under this chapter,
- 19 the court may order the applicant in the guardianship proceeding to
- 20 pay that cost.
- 21 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 669, Texas Probate Code,
- 22 is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 669. COSTS IN [ACAINST] GUARDIANSHIP PROCEEDING
- 24 GENERALLY.

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 669, Texas Probate Code, is amended by
- 2 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this section, in
- 5 a guardianship matter, the cost of the proceeding, including the
- 6 cost of the guardian ad litem or court visitor, shall be paid out of
- 7 the guardianship estate, or, if the estate is insufficient to pay
- 8 for the cost of the proceeding, the cost of the proceeding shall be
- 9 paid out of the county treasury, except as provided by Subsection
- 10 (c) of this section, and the judgment of the court shall be issued
- 11 accordingly.
- 12 (c) If the guardianship estate is insufficient to pay for
- 13 the cost of the guardian ad litem in a guardianship proceeding, the
- 14 court may order the applicant in the proceeding to pay that cost.
- 15 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a
- 16 guardianship created before, on, or after the effective date of
- 17 this Act.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
