## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the reporting of political contributions and 3 expenditures.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 254.031(a), Election Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this chapter, each8 report filed under this chapter must include:

9 (1) the amount of political contributions from each 10 person that in the aggregate exceed \$50 and that are accepted during 11 the reporting period by the person or committee required to file a 12 report under this chapter, the full name and address of the person 13 making the contributions, and the dates of the contributions;

14 (2) the amount of loans that are made during the reporting period for campaign or officeholder purposes to the 15 16 person or committee required to file the report and that in the aggregate exceed \$50, the dates the loans are made, the interest 17 rate, the maturity date, the type of collateral for the loans, if 18 any, the full name and address of the person or financial 19 institution making the loans, the full name and address, principal 20 21 occupation, and name of the employer of each guarantor of the loans, the amount of the loans guaranteed by each guarantor, and the 22 23 aggregate principal amount of all outstanding loans as of the last day of the reporting period; 24

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(3) the amount of political expenditures that in the
aggregate exceed \$50 and that are made during the reporting period,
the full name and address of the persons to whom the expenditures
are made, and the dates and purposes of the expenditures;

5 (4) the amount of each payment made during the 6 reporting period from a political contribution if the payment is 7 not a political expenditure, the full name and address of the person 8 to whom the payment is made, and the date and purpose of the 9 payment;

10 (5) the total amount or a specific listing of the 11 political contributions of \$50 or less accepted and the total 12 amount or a specific listing of the political expenditures of \$50 or 13 less made during the reporting period;

14 (6) the total amount of all political contributions 15 accepted and the total amount of all political expenditures made 16 during the reporting period;

(7) the name of each candidate or officeholder who benefits from a direct campaign expenditure made during the reporting period by the person or committee required to file the report, and the office sought or held, excluding a direct campaign expenditure that is made by the principal political committee of a political party on behalf of a slate of two or more nominees of that party; [and]

(8) as of the last day of a reporting period for which the person is required to file a report, the total amount of political contributions accepted, including interest or other income on those contributions, maintained in one or more accounts

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1	in which political contributions are deposited as of the last day of
2	the reporting period;
3	(9) the following amounts received during the
4	reporting period:
5	(A) any credit, interest, rebate, refund,
6	reimbursement, or return of a deposit fee resulting from the use of
7	a political contribution or an asset purchased with a political
8	<pre>contribution;</pre>
9	(B) any proceeds of the sale of an asset or
10	investment purchased with a political contribution; and
11	(C) any other gain received from a political
12	contribution; and
13	(10) the full name and address of each person from whom
14	an amount described by Subdivision (9) is received, the date the
15	amount is received, and the purpose for which the amount is
16	received.
17	SECTION 2. Section 305.005, Government Code, is amended by
18	adding Subsection (1) to read as follows:
19	(1) The registration form must include the full name and
20	address of each person who compensates or reimburses the registrant
21	for any reason from:
22	(1) a political contribution as defined by Title 15,
23	Election Code;
24	(2) interest received from a political contribution as
25	defined by Title 15, Election Code; or
26	(3) an asset purchased with a political contribution
27	as defined by Title 15, Election Code.

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1 SECTION 3. (a) Section 254.031(a), Election Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a report under Chapter 254, 2 Election Code, that is required to be filed on or after the 3 4 effective date of this Act. A report under Chapter 254, Election Code, that is required to be filed before the effective date of this 5 Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the report is 6 required to be filed, and the former law is continued in effect for 7 8 that purpose.

9 (b) Section 305.005(1), Government Code, as added by this 10 Act, applies only to compensation or reimbursement received by a 11 registrant under Chapter 305, Government Code, on or after the 12 effective date of this Act.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
