No. 2466 1 (4) has submitted to the department written parental 2 or guardian permission: 3 (A) for the department to access the applicant's school enrollment records maintained by the Texas Education Agency; 4 5 and 6 (B) for a school administrator or law enforcement 7 officer to notify the department in the event that the person has been absent from school for at least 20 consecutive instructional 8 days; and 9 10 (5) has passed the examination required by Section 521.161. 11 SECTION 2. Section 521.295(a), Transportation Code, 12 is amended to read as follows: 13 14 (a) If the department suspends a person's license under 15 Section 521.292 or revokes a person's license under Section 521.294 or 521.2965, the department shall send a notice of suspension or 16 17 revocation by first class mail to the person's address in the records of the department. 18 SECTION 3. Section 521.296, Transportation Code, is amended 19 to read as follows: 20 Sec. 521.296. NOTICE OF SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION. A notice 21 of suspension under Section 521.292 or revocation under Section 22 521.294 must state: 23 24 (1) the reason and statutory grounds for the 25 suspension or revocation; (2) the effective date of 26 the suspension or

Section 545.424, Transportation Code, is amended by amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsections (a-1) 6 7 and (b-1) to read as follows: 8 (a) A person under 18 years of age may not operate a motor vehicle while using a wireless communications device, except in 9 10 case of emergency. (a-1) A person under 18 years of age may not operate a motor 11 12 vehicle[+ [(1)] during the 12-month period following issuance of 13 14 an original Class A, B, or C driver's license to the person: 15 (1) [(A)] after midnight and before 5 a.m. unless the operation of the vehicle is necessary for the operator to attend or 16 17 participate in employment or a school-related activity or because of a medical emergency; or 18 (2) [(B)] with more than one passenger in the vehicle 19 under 21 years of age who is not a family member [; or 20 21 [(2) while using a wireless communications device, except in case of emergency]. 22 A person under 17 years of age who holds a restricted 23 (b) 24 motorcycle license or moped license <u>may not operate a motorcycle or</u> moped while using a wireless communications device, except in case 25 26 of emergency. 27 (b-1) A person under 17 years of age who holds a restricted

1 <u>motorcycle license or moped license</u>, during the 12-month period 2 following the issuance of an original motorcycle license or moped 3 license to the person, may not operate a motorcycle or moped[+ 4 [(1)] after midnight and before 5 a.m. unless: 5 (1) [(A)] the person is in sight of the person's parent 6 or guardian; or

7 (2) [(B)] the operation of the vehicle is necessary 8 for the operator to attend or participate in employment or a 9 school-related activity or because of a medical emergency[; or

10 [(2) while using a wireless communications device, 11 except in case of emergency].

SECTION 5. Section 521.271(a-1), Transportation Code, is repealed.

14 SECTION 6. The change in law made by Section 521.204(a), 15 Transportation Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a 16 license issued on or after the effective date of this Act.

17 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
