## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the registration of a referee of certain
3	extracurricular athletic activities sponsored or sanctioned by
4	certain public or private schools; providing penalties.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 13, Occupations Code, is
7	amended by adding Chapter 2053 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 2053. REFEREES
9	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
10	Sec. 2053.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
11	(1) "Commission" means the Texas Commission of
12	Licensing and Regulation.
13	(2) "Department" means the Texas Department of
14	Licensing and Regulation.
15	(3) "Referee" means a person who:
16	(A) is present on the field or court during an
17	athletic or sporting event; and
18	(B) exercises supervision over the event and its
19	participants.
20	Sec. 2053.002. APPLICABILITY. This chapter applies only to
21	a referee of an extracurricular athletic activity sponsored or
22	sanctioned by a public or private elementary or secondary school
23	who receives payment for the referee's services from the school, a
21	school district or an organization that contracts with the school

- 1 or school district to provide referee services.
- 2 Sec. 2053.003. PREEMPTION. A political subdivision of this
- 3 state, the University Interscholastic League, a state agency, or
- 4 another entity may not adopt a registration requirement for a
- 5 referee to whom this chapter applies.

- 7 <u>SUBCHAPTER B. DEPARTMENT POWERS AND DUTIES</u>
- 8 Sec. 2053.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The department
- 9 shall administer and enforce this chapter.
- Sec. 2053.102. RULEMAKING AUTHORITY. The commission shall
- 11 adopt rules necessary to administer and enforce this chapter.
- 12 [Sections 2053.103-2053.200 reserved for expansion]
- SUBCHAPTER C. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS
- Sec. 2053.201. <u>REGISTRATION REQUIRED</u>. A person may not act
- 15 as a referee of an extracurricular athletic activity sponsored or
- 16 sanctioned by a public or private elementary or secondary school
- 17 and held in this state unless the person is an individual who is
- 18 registered with the department under this chapter.
- 19 Sec. 2053.202. ELIGIBILITY FOR REGISTRATION. An individual
- 20 is eligible for registration under this chapter if the individual:
- 21 (1) is at least 18 years of age; and
- 22 (2) satisfies the requirements of this chapter and
- 23 rules adopted under this chapter.
- Sec. 2053.203. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS. An applicant for
- 25 registration as a referee must apply on a form prescribed by the
- 26 department and submit a registration fee in the amount set by the
- 27 commission.

- 1 Sec. 2053.204. TERM OF REGISTRATION. A certificate of
- 2 registration issued under this chapter is valid for the period
- 3 prescribed by the commission.

- 5 SUBCHAPTER D. REFUSAL TO REGISTER AND DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES
- 6 Sec. 2053.301. REFUSAL TO REGISTER; SUSPENSION OR
- 7 REVOCATION OF REGISTRATION. The commission may refuse to register
- 8 or suspend or revoke the certificate of registration of any person
- 9 for:
- 10 (1) violating this chapter or a rule adopted under
- 11 this chapter; or
- 12 (2) making a substantial misrepresentation in an
- 13 application for registration.
- 14 [Sections 2053.302-2053.400 reserved for expansion]
- SUBCHAPTER E. ENFORCEMENT
- 16 Sec. 2053.401. DISCIPLINARY ACTION; ADMINISTRATIVE
- 17 PENALTY. A person who violates this chapter or a rule adopted under
- 18 this chapter is subject to any action or penalty authorized under
- 19 Subchapter F or G, Chapter 51.
- SECTION 2. (a) Not later than December 1, 2011, the Texas
- 21 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules,
- 22 standards, procedures, and fees necessary to implement Chapter
- 23 2053, Occupations Code, as added by this Act.
- 24 (b) Notwithstanding Section 2053.201, Occupations Code, as
- 25 added by this Act, a referee is not required to register under that
- 26 section before January 1, 2012.
- 27 SECTION 3. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this

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- 1 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
- 2 (b) Subchapter E, Chapter 2053, Occupations Code, as added
- 3 by this Act, takes effect January 1, 2012.
