A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article V, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 32 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 32. A court of this state shall uphold the laws of the
- 8 Constitution of the United States, this Constitution, federal laws,
- 9 and laws of this state. A court of this state may not enforce,
- 10 consider, or apply any religious or cultural law.
- 11 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 12 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011.
- 13 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 14 proposition: "The constitutional amendment prohibiting a court of
- 15 this state from enforcing, considering, or applying a religious or
- 16 cultural law."
