## A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature 2 to permit a county to issue bonds or notes to finance the 3 development or redevelopment of an unproductive, underdeveloped, 4 or blighted area and to pledge for repayment of the bonds or notes 5 increases in ad valorem taxes imposed by the county on property in 6 the area.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

8 SECTION 1. Section 1-g(b), Article VIII, Texas 9 Constitution, is amended to read as follows:

The legislature by general law may authorize 10 (b) an incorporated city or town or a county to issue bonds or notes to 11 12 finance the development or redevelopment of an unproductive, underdeveloped, or blighted area within the city, [or] town, or 13 county and to pledge for repayment of those bonds or notes increases 14 in ad valorem tax revenues imposed on property in the area by the 15 16 city, [or] town, or county and other political subdivisions.

SECTION 2.
