1 (c) An application under this section must give written notice to an applicant that information regarding alternative 2 service options for applicants who object to conventional military 3 service for religious or other conscientious reasons is available 4 from the department upon request. 5

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- (d) The applicant's submission of the application following this notification constitutes the applicant's consent to the sending of the information and the [The department shall develop by a selective service consent statement as a part of the application for an original, renewal, or duplicate driver's license 10 or personal identification certificate. The consent statement must include a place to indicate consent or declination to register with the United States Selective Service System and must state the benefits and penalties associated with consent or declination to The department shall present the statement to applicant who is subject to registration with the Selective Service System and record the applicant's response. A response is required to complete the application for a license or certificate for such 18 applicant. The department shall forward to the Selective Service 19 System, in an electronic format, only the information necessary for 20 registration of an applicant consenting to] registration. 21
- 22 (e) [(b)] In addition to the <u>notifications</u> [statement] required by Subsections (b) and (c) [Subsection (a)], 23 department may conspicuously post at each location where 24 25 applications for driver's licenses and personal identification certificates are accepted one or more signs, in English and 26 27 Spanish, providing the information contained in the notifications
