**IN RE: HB167** by Raymond (Relating to the transportation of certain mental health patients.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend Section 574.045(a) of the Health and Safety Code to revise the order of priority of who the court may authorize to transport a patient committed or detained to a designated mental health facility. The Department of State Health Services and the Office of Court Administration estimate there will be no significant fiscal impact to the state.
