FLOOR AMENDMENT NO.

- Amend S.B. No. 347 (House committee printing) as follows:
- 2 (1) On page 1, line 6, between "by" and "adding", insert
- 3 "amending Subsection (e) and".
- 4 (2) On page 1, between lines 6 and 7, insert the
- 5 following:
- 6 (e) The commission may transfer money from the low-level
- 7 radioactive waste fund to the perpetual care account to make
- 8 payments required by the commission under Section 401.303. The
- 9 commission shall notify the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste
- 10 Disposal Compact Commission of an action the commission takes
- 11 under this subsection.
- 12 (3) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS and
- 13 renumber any subsequent SECTIONS accordingly:
- 14 SECTION ___. Section 401.207, Health and Safety Code, is
- amended by adding Subsections (d-1), (d-2), (d-3), (e-1) and (e-1)
- 16 2) and amending Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 17 (d-1) Beginning September 1, 2015, the compact waste
- 18 disposal facility license holder may accept nonparty compact
- 19 waste for disposal at the facility only if:
- 20 (1) the waste has been volume-reduced, if eligible,
- 21 by at least a factor of three in a manner consistent with this
- 22 subchapter as provided by commission rule; and
- 23 (2) the compact waste disposal facility license
- holder collects a fee under Section 401.249(f).
- 25 (d-2) If volume reduction of a low-level radioactive waste
- 26 stream would result in a change of waste classification to a
- 27 class higher than Class C, the payment of the fee and compliance
- 28 with other requirements of Subsection (d-1) do not apply.
- (d-3) The commission may assess an additional fee on a

- 1 nonparty compact waste generator for failing to comply with the
- 2 volume reduction requirements established under this section.
- 3 The fee shall be deposited to the credit of the low-level
- 4 radioactive waste fund under Section 401.249(f). Fees deposited
- 5 under this subsection may be transferred and used only to
- 6 support the operations of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste
- 7 Disposal Compact Commission under Section 401.251.
- 8 (e) The compact waste disposal facility license holder may
- 9 not collect a fee under this section or enter into a contract
- 10 for the disposal of nonparty low-level radioactive waste that
- 11 has been designated as Class A low-level radioactive waste under
- 12 10 C.F.R. Section 61.55 and commission rule unless the waste is
- 13 containerized. The compact waste disposal facility license
- 14 holder may collect a fee and dispose of:
- 15 (1) not more than the greater of:
- 16 (A) 1.167 million curies of nonparty compact
- 17 waste; or
- 18 (B) an amount of nonparty compact waste equal to
- 19 30 percent of the initial licensed capacity of the facility; and
- 20 (2) not more than 275,000 curies of nonparty compact
- 21 <u>waste in any fiscal year</u> [accept more than 50,000 total cubic
- 22 feet of nonparty compact waste annually. The compact waste
- 23 disposal facility license holder may not accept more than
- 24 120,000 curies of nonparty compact waste annually, except that
- 25 in the first year the license holder may accept 220,000
- 26 curies].
- 27 (e-1) The legislature by general law may establish revised
- 28 limits under Subsection (e) after considering the results of the
- 29 study under Section 401.208.
- 30 (e-2) $[\frac{(e-1)}{(e-1)}]$ The commission's executive director, on
- 31 completion of the study under Section 401.208, may prohibit the

- 1 license holder from accepting any additional nonparty compact
- 2 waste if the commission determines from the study that the
- 3 capacity of the facility will be limited, regardless of whether
- 4 the limit under Subsection (f) has been reached.
- 5 SECTION . Section 401.218, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) In addition to the fees charged to support the
- 8 operations of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal
- 9 Compact Commission, the commission's executive director may
- 10 charge a license holder a fee to cover the administrative costs
- 11 of the executive director's action to adjust, correct, or
- 12 otherwise modify a license.
- 13 SECTION . The changes in law made by this Act apply
- 14 only to a contract for the disposal of compact waste or nonparty
- 15 compact waste that is signed on or after the effective date of
- 16 this Act. A contract signed before the effective date of this
- 17 Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the contract
- 18 was signed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 19 purpose.
