5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
7	is amended by adding Section 521.127 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 521.127. CONCEALED HANDGUN DESIGNATION. The
9	department shall include on each driver's license issued to a
10	person licensed to carry a concealed handgun under Subchapter H,
11	Chapter 411, Government Code, who makes an election under Section
12	411.1795, Government Code, a designation that shows the person is
13	licensed under that subchapter. The designation must include the
14	person's handgun license number, a statement of the period for
15	which the concealed handgun license is effective, and the category

- 5 amended by adding Section 411.1795 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 411.1795. DRIVER'S LICENSE DESIGNATION. (a) The
- 7 department shall adopt rules allowing an applicant for the
- 8 <u>issuance</u>, modification, or renewal of a license under this
- 9 subchapter, in addition to or instead of being issued, modifying,
- 10 or renewing the license, to elect to include on the person's
- 11 driver's license a designation indicating that the person is
- 12 licensed under this subchapter. The rules must include procedures
- 13 to ensure that a person who makes an election under this section
- 14 receives and maintains a designation on the person's driver's
- 15 <u>license only if the person meets the requirements for the issuance</u>
- 16 or modification and any necessary renewal of the license under this
- 17 subchapter.
- 18 (b) The department may collect a fee from a person who makes
- 19 an election under this section in an amount necessary to cover the
- 20 cost of administering this section.
- 21 SECTION 4. Section 411.205, Government Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- Sec. 411.205. REQUIREMENT TO DISPLAY LICENSE. If a license
- 24 holder is carrying a handgun on or about the license holder's person
- 25 when a magistrate or a peace officer demands that the license holder
- 26 display identification, the license holder shall display either:
- 27 (1) the license holder's driver's license that

- 1 includes a concealed handgun designation under Section 521.127 or
- 2 522.030, Transportation Code; or
- 3 (2) both the license holder's driver's license or
- 4 identification certificate issued by the department and the license
- 5 holder's handgun license.
- 6 SECTION 5. The Department of Public Safety shall adopt
- 7 rules as required by Sections 521.127 and 522.030(d),
- 8 Transportation Code, and 411.1795, Government Code, as added by
- 9 this Act, not later than November 1, 2013.
- 10 SECTION 6. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to a license issued or renewed under Subchapter H, Chapter 411,
- 12 Government Code, or Chapter 521 or 522, Transportation Code, on or
- 13 after January 1, 2014.
- 14 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
