8	(c) Subsection (a)(8) does not authorize a municipality to
9	confiscate packaged, unopened fireworks.
10	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 342, Local Government
11	Code, is amended by adding Section 342.013 to read as follows:
12	Sec. 342.013. CONFISCATION OF CERTAIN FIREWORKS
13	PROHIBITED; AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE. (a) A home-rule municipality that
14	regulates fireworks may not confiscate packaged, unopened
15	fireworks.
16	(b) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution for
17	possession of fireworks brought under a municipal ordinance that:
18	(1) the defendant was operating or was a passenger in a
19	motor vehicle that was being operated in a public place; and
20	(2) the fireworks were not in the passenger area of the
21	vehicle.
22	(c) For purposes of Subsection (b), the "passenger area" of
23	a motor vehicle means the area of the vehicle designed for the
24	seating of the operator and the passengers of the vehicle. The term

1	does not include:
2	(1) a locked glove compartment or similar locked
3	storage area;
4	(2) the trunk of a vehicle; or
5	(3) the area behind the last upright seat of a vehicle
6	that does not have a trunk.
7	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
8	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
9	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
10	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

11 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
