- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 521.1655, Transportation
- 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 521.1655. TESTING BY DRIVER EDUCATION SCHOOL AND
- 9 CERTAIN DRIVER EDUCATION COURSE PROVIDERS.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 521.1655, Transportation Code, is
- 11 amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 12 <u>(a-1)</u> A driver education course provider approved under
- 13 Section 521.205 or a person who conducts a course under that section
- 14 may administer to a student of that course the highway sign and
- 15 traffic law parts of the examination required by Section 521.161.
- SECTION 3. Section 521.205(c), Transportation Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (c) The rules must provide a method by which:
- 19 (1) approval of a course is obtained;
- 20 (2) an applicant submits proof of completion of the
- 21 course; [and]
- 22 (3) approval for delivering course materials by an
- 23 alternative method, including electronic means, is obtained;
- 24 (4) a provider of a course approved under this section

- 1 or a person conducting a course under this section may administer to
- 2 an applicant the highway sign and traffic law parts of the
- 3 <u>examination</u> as provided by Section 521.1655(a-1) through
- 4 <u>electronic means; and</u>
- 5 <u>(5) an applicant submits proof of passage of an</u>
- 6 examination administered under Subdivision (4).
- 7 SECTION 4. The Department of Public Safety shall adopt the
- 8 rules required by Section 521.205, Transportation Code, as amended
- 9 by this Act, not later than January 1, 2014.
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
