4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 171, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 171.0031 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 171.0031. REQUIREMENTS OF PHYSICIAN; OFFENSE. (a) A
8	physician performing or inducing an abortion must, on the date the
9	abortion is performed, have active admitting privileges at a
10	hospital that:
11	(1) is located not further than 30 miles from the
12	location at which the abortion is performed or induced; and
13	(2) provides obstetrical or gynecological health care
14	services.
15	(b) A physician who violates Subsection (a) commits an
16	offense. An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
