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(c) A person or group of persons accepts political contributions if its members or donors make a payment, including dues, to the person or group of persons and, at the time of making the payments, the members or donors have reason to know that their payments may be used to make political contributions or political expenditures or may be commingled with other funds used to make political contributions or political expenditures.

9 <u>Sec. 254.282. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.</u> (a) Except as 10 <u>otherwise provided by this subchapter, a person or group of persons</u> 11 <u>shall comply with this chapter as if the person or group of persons</u> 12 <u>were the campaign treasurer of a general-purpose committee that</u> 13 <u>does not file monthly reports under Section 254.155.</u>

14 (b) A person or group of persons is not required to file a
15 campaign treasurer appointment for making expenditures or
16 contributions for which reporting is required under this section
17 unless the person is otherwise required to file a campaign
18 treasurer appointment under this title.

27 Sec. 254.283. CONTENTS OF REPORT. (a) Itemization of a

1 contribution under Section 254.031(a)(1) is required only if the 2 contribution exceeds \$1,000 during the reporting period.

3 (b) The first report required to be filed in a calendar year
4 in which the \$25,000 threshold under Section 254.281(a)(3) is
5 exceeded must include all political contributions accepted and all
6 political expenditures made in that calendar year.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
