1 AN ACT relating to annual and special meetings of and election procedures 2 3 for members of boards of directors for water supply or sewer service 4 corporations. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 67.0052, Water Code, is amended by amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (d) to read 7 as follows: 8 (a) To be listed on the ballot as a candidate for a 9 10 director's position, a person must file an application with the corporation that includes: 11 12 (1)the director's position sought, including any 13 position number or other distinguishing number; 14 if the corporation has 1,500 or more members or (2) 15 shareholders, a petition [7] signed by [the lesser of] 20 members or shareholders [or five percent of the members or shareholders,] 16 17 requesting that the person's name be placed on the ballot as a candidate for that position; 18 19 the person's written consent to serve, if elected; (3) (4) biographical information about the person; and 20 21 (5) statement of the person's qualifications, а 22 including a statement that the person has the qualifications prescribed by Section 67.0051. 23 (b) The application must be filed with the corporation not 24

later than the 45th day before the date of the annual meeting. 1 The corporation shall notify the members or shareholders of 2 the application deadline not later than the 30th day before the 3 4 deadline. 5 (d) This section applies only to a corporation that provides 6 retail water or sewer service. 7 SECTION 2. Section 67.0053, Water Code, is amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: 8 9 (c) This section: 10 (1) applies only to a corporation that provides retail 11 water or sewer service; and (2) does not apply to an election in relation to a 12 13 candidate for a director's position for which the board has adopted a resolution under Section 67.0055. 14 SECTION 3. Section 67.0054, Water Code, is amended by 15 16 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (g) to read as 17 follows: 18 (c) For each director's position, the candidate who receives the highest number of votes or who is the subject of a 19 resolution described by Section 67.0055 is elected. 20 (g) This section applies only to a corporation that provides 21 22 retail water or sewer service. SECTION 4. Subchapter A, Chapter 67, Water Code, is amended 23 24 by adding Section 67.0055 to read as follows: 25 Sec. 67.0055. ELECTION OF UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE. (a) This section applies only to an election for a director's position on a 26 27 board of a corporation that provides retail water or sewer service

No. 447 1 in which a candidate who is to appear on the ballot for the position 2 is unopposed. 3 (b) The board by resolution may declare a candidate elected 4 to a director's position if the board certifies in writing that the candidate is unopposed for the position. A copy of the resolution 5 6 shall be posted at the corporation's main office. 7 (c) If a declaration is made under Subsection (b), the 8 election for that position is not held. 9 (d) If the election for the unopposed candidate would have been held with an annual meeting of the members or shareholders of 10 11 the corporation, the text of the declaration described by Subsection (b) shall be read into the record at the annual meeting. 12 13 (e) The ballots used at a separate election that is held at the same time as an election for an unopposed candidate would have 14 been held shall include after measures or contested races the 15 position and name of a candidate declared elected under this 16 section, under the heading "Unopposed Candidates Declared 17 Elected." 18 (f) A person may not, by intimidation or by means of 19 20 coercion, influence or attempt to influence a person to withdraw as a candidate or not to file an application for a place on the ballot 21 22 so that an election may be canceled. The board may adopt necessary rules or bylaws to 23 (g) implement this section, including rules or bylaws to ensure the 24 fairness, integrity, and openness of the process. 25 26 SECTION 5. The heading to Section 67.007, Water Code, is 27 amended to read as follows:

1 Sec. 67.007. ANNUAL OR SPECIAL MEETING <u>OF RETAIL</u> 2 <u>CORPORATION</u>.

3 SECTION 6. Section 67.007, Water Code, is amended by adding
4 Subsection (e) to read as follows:

5 (e) This section applies only to a corporation that provides
6 retail water or sewer service.

SECTION 7. Subchapter A, Chapter 67, Water Code, is amended
by adding Section 67.0075 to read as follows:

9 <u>Sec. 67.0075. ANNUAL OR SPECIAL MEETING OF OTHER</u> 10 <u>CORPORATION. A corporation to which Section 67.007 does not apply</u> 11 <u>shall comply with the annual meeting and director election</u> 12 <u>provisions prescribed by Chapter 22, Business Organizations Code.</u>

13 SECTION 8. The change in law made by this Act applies only 14 to an annual or special meeting or a director election held on or 15 after the 75th day after the effective date of this Act. A meeting 16 or an election held before the 75th day after the effective date of 17 this Act is governed by the law in effect when the meeting or 18 election was held, and that law is continued in effect for that 19 purpose.

20 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
