3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 23.83, Tax Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	(a) A person is entitled to have land he owns appraised
7	under this subchapter if, on January 1:
8	(1) the land is restricted as provided by this
9	subchapter and its use is available to the public without a fee or
10	for a nominal fee;
11	(2) the land is used in a way that does not result in
12	accrual of distributable profits, realization of private gain
13	resulting from payment of compensation in excess of a reasonable
14	allowance for salary or other compensation for services rendered,
15	or realization of any other form of private gain;
16	(3) the land has been devoted exclusively to
17	recreational, park, or scenic uses for the preceding year; and
18	(4) he is using and intends to use the land exclusively
19	for those purposes in the current year.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
